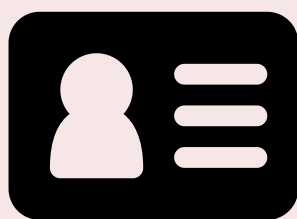

# Main Requirements

To embark on the path to Grenada Citizenship, here are the main criteria.

## Age Requirement:

The main applicant must be a minimum of 18 years old to initiate the application process.

## Investment Options:

Choose your journey by opting for one of the three investment avenues economic contribution or purchase of one of two types of real estate):

- National Transformation Fund Contribution: Make a significant economic contribution of USD 150,000 to Grenada's National Transformation Fund.
- Real Estate Investment (Co-ownership): Invest USD 220,000 in real estate, securing your place through co-ownership.

## Streamlined application process

### 1. Consultation and Property Selection

Seek guidance from Schinder Consultant London immigration consultants, and if applicable, choose a property for investment.
